Outpatient Development Plans

Last year we invested £1.5m to transform our Main Outpatients Department. The initial phase of the redevelopment was completed in June this year and included a new entrance, patient calling system, appointment desk, café and open plan ground floor and upstairs waiting areas. The second and final phase of the work has now begun and includes improvements to the outpatient waiting areas, new patient toilet facilities, and refurbishing the x ray reception, waiting areas and changing facilities.
