- Instructions regarding your medications will be given at your pre-assessment appointment. At this appointment any changes to your current medications will be discussed and documented in the box titled medications above.
- **NOTE** Please bring all your tablets and eye drops/creams/inhalers with you on the day of admission.
- Please have a shower or bath before coming to Hospital.
- Please wear loose fitting clean clothes and flat comfortable shoes.
- Please remove all nail varnish and jewellery.
- **Please do not bring money and valuables with you, including, as secure storage facilities in the Unit are limited.**
- Further information will be given regarding post-operative care on completion of your treatment.
